



2012 APPLICATION INFORMATION

Pettipaug Sailing Academy is pleased to announce our program offerings for the Summer of 2012. Sailing classes are designed for boys and girls between the ages 8 thru 16, regardless of previous sailing experience. Instructors will stress basic sailing skills, seamanship, sportsmanship and the fun of sailing. More advanced students will learn the finer points of boat handling, racing tactics, and have the opportunity to participate in inter-club team racing.

Class Schedules

The Sailing Academy program runs for **seven (7) weeks from July 2nd to August 17th**. Shortened courses of instruction of 3 1/2 weeks are available from **July 2nd to July 24th** and from **July 26th to August 17th**. Classes are held Monday through Friday in two sessions: **Morning, 9:00-12:00 and Afternoon, 1:00-4:00**. Graduation will be held the evening of August 17th at 6:00pm. Students may request either the morning or afternoon session. However, morning classes are best for beginners and students eleven and under. Afternoon classes are better suited for more experienced sailors and age twelve and older. Being with school classmates and peers should be taken into consideration. Other class assignments will be based on sailing experience and on a first registered/ first served basis.

Tuition

\$600 per student for the seven-week program; \$375 per student for the shortened program. A \$75 non-refundable deposit must accompany the completed application. Early registration is important to obtain a desired session.

Deadline Categories for Enrollment

Group 1 – Students that were enrolled in PSA last year and their siblings:

Enrolled if they send in deposit by March 15.

Group 2 – Applicants who submitted applications last year and were wait-listed:

Enrolled if they send in deposit by March 30 – and if there is space available after Group 1.

Group 3 – New applicants:

Enrolled first come, first served – and if there is space available after Group 1 & 2.

Boat Donation Tuition Refund

Families who supply a fully equipped and sound optimist or Blue Jay for use in the full seven-week program will be entitled to a partial tuition refund for immediate family members. (See "A Note About Boat Donations") Full tuition is to be paid in advance of attending class, and a partial tuition refund will be made two weeks after the boat is checked out at the end of the seven-week program. **Refunds will be made only for boats accepted into the program. Any boat judged by the staff to be unsafe or improperly equipped, or any boat not delivered at the PSA "Check-In" on June 23rd will be refused.**

Pettipaug Yacht Club Membership

Although membership in Pettipaug Yacht Club is not required for enrollment in Pettipaug Sailing Academy, junior memberships (under age 21) are available for \$15.00. Junior membership entitles the student use of the club for the season and is required for participation in some regattas.

Forms

A completed application form, including medical information and a legal parent or guardians signature must be provided to enroll a student in any Pettipaug program. Please note any allergies, special medication, and physical or learning disabilities your child may have. This information will be kept confidential.
