Membership & Security

The Board of Governors has addressed several sensitive and worrisome issues these past few months, namely, what is meant by a "Member in Good Standing" and how best to safeguard the club from abuse, negligence and outright theft and vandalism.

First, the following definition for "PYC Membership" will be added to the 2011 Yearbook:

A PYC member is considered to be a "Member in Good Standing" only when their dues are paid up to date. The member is then eligible to enjoy all the rights and privileges of membership. Dues are payable no later than April 1st of each year and must be received by that date for a member's name to appear in the Yearbook. Any member who is delinquent in their dues is not entitled to any rights or privileges of membership or any use of the club until all back dues are paid. Failure to pay dues for two consecutive years will require re-application for new membership.

Second, the blatant abuse of the "firepit," the mess left by after-dark partiers and the theft of PYC and personal property necessitates a clear emphasis of the Rules regarding the use of the club:

- The club is closed after dark to all members and their guests unless a sponsoring member has signed a "Club Use Agreement" authorizing the use of PYC for a special event. The Agreement must be in-hand during the event. (Note: PYC Officers and Governors listed in the current 2010 Yearbook are the only ones allowed to be at the club after dark.)
- A Club Use Agreement will be needed for parties of 12 or more, or for any use of the Club after sunset.
- The Essex Police will patrol evenings and ticket anyone, including members and/ or their children, for trespassing after dark. A monthly schedule of special events by those who have secured a Club Use Agreement will be left with the town police. But, to repeat: The Agreement must be in-hand by the sponsoring member during the event.
- More than one ticket for trespassing by a member and/or a member's children will necessitate a review of one's membership by the Board of Governors.
- Except for the propane grill, no open fires are permitted at any time. (Note: The fireplace in the clubhouse, which is in need of repair, may only be used under the supervision of a Board member.)

PYC is a special place that nearly 400 members can enjoy. As members, it's all our responsibility to safeguard it for ourselves and future generations. Please party responsibly.
